
We have been attempting to comply with the new IRS requirement to file Form 990-PF electronically. However, this is proving to be extremely difficult. For reasons of availability and affordability, this represents a significant hardship for our small organization. I mailed an e-file Waiver Request on December 3, 2020 after several failed attempts to fax the request to the fax number provided in Notice 2010-13, 2010-4 I.R.B. 327. We have received no reply from the IRS about this request.

On the irs.gov web site, I found instructions stating that since we are unable to file electronically by the due date of our return that we should submit a printed return. Therefore, I am sending a printed return at this time. I used the IRS-provided fill-in PDF file of Form 990-PF, and I am also enclosing a CD containing our filled-in PDF document.

As I understand, the IRS offers a Free File Fillable Forms service that will convert the electronic file I am sending to you now so that it meets the electronic filing requirement. I attempted to use the service this year, but it is not available from October to January. Since our fiscal year is from August 1 to July 31, we need the service in the exact time of year that it is unavailable. For 2020's return, I will attempt to complete our forms immediately after the fiscal year ends and submit them during the short window in September during which this service should still be available.
